Purpose Driven Life – Led by Charlene Feeback

This course meets five weeks.

The most basic questions everyone faces in life are: Why am I here? What is my purpose? This study pursues answers to these questions from a Biblical perspective. The group will explore the connection between our purpose and the work of the church. The book, **The Purpose Driven Life**, by Rick Warren, is the basis of the study. Faith in Public Life - Led by Pastor Spencer Stith

This course meets five weeks.

“A faith that makes a difference authentically is a faith that guides what we do in the world and that shapes how we understand the world and our place in it.”

This Book Discussion Group uses **A Public Faith: How Followers of Faith Should Serve the Common Good**, by Miroslav Volf, to explore these and other questions.

1. In what ways does the Christian Faith malfunction in the contemporary world, and how should we counter these malfunctions?
2. What should be the main concern of Christ’s followers when it comes to being an instrument of God for the sake of human flourishing, in this life and the next?

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Parent Roundtable – Led by Pastor Mike DeVries

This group meets February 26 and March 4.

The purpose of the Parent Roundtable is for parents to come together to learn from each other in how we deal with our students and the issues they face. Being a parent is a great responsibility but not always easy.

Financial Peace University – Led by Pastor Mike Parrett
